Letter from the Administrator

Innovative Staffing Model Draws Three New Physicians

Did you notice we recently expanded our roster of primary care providers to seven? It's been exciting to add three physicians - Drs. Sunny Gill, Lonny Miller and Daniel Schnadt - to our team!

How did it happen so quickly? That's a story worth sharing. Facing a nationwide shortage of healthcare providers, we approached the recruitment process differently. We opted for a new staffing model that offers physicians a seven-days-on, 14-days-off rotation. With this innovative model, providers split their time between primary care in the CMH Medical Clinic and our emergency department.

The new model was received well during recruitment, as we had inquiries from seven physicians. Conversely, only one provider had interest in a traditional scheduling model.

A few more details:

- Each seven-day schedule runs Monday at 7 a.m. to the following Monday at 7 a.m.
- How do they manage 24-hour shifts? On average, there's a tremendous drop-off in ER volume overnight, so our providers get the opportunity to rest.
- We beat the projected timeline. We were cautioned it typically takes 18 months to get physicians signed and ready. However, within six months, all three physicians were on board and ready to work.
- All three of these primary care providers are accepting new patients in the clinic. And if they happen to be off-duty when a patient requires further care, each provides hand-off notes to the other providers. In addition, the same nurse works with all three providers to help with continuity of care.

Of course, patients may continue to see any of our existing PCPs in Sumner, which includes Dr. Shanna Elliott, Spencer Kleitsch, ARNP, and Krista Begalske, ARNP (call 563-578-5375 to schedule). Patients may also see Dr. Lucas Brinkman in Fredericksburg (call 563-237-5316 to schedule).

Better yet, the new staffing model helps our new physicians maintain full-time status, while allowing comfortable work-life balance.

Thank you for your patience with this transition. We've never been positioned better to provide care for the patients and communities we serve



In an effort to make lab testing available to surrounding communities at affordable prices, Community Memorial Hospital is holding a Wellness Testing event:

• Wednesday, April 24, 2024, from 6:30 to 8 a.m. at St. Peter's Church in Denver.

The basic wellness panel is \$30 and includes blood counts, blood salts, blood sugar, cholesterol, kidney function tests and liver enzymes. Additional tests are available for added cost. This event is open to anyone and no registration is required. Wellness testing is available without an appointment at CMH Monday through Friday 7 a.m. - 5 p.m.

Senior Life Solutions

Community Memorial Hospital's Senior Life Solutions department is an intensive outpatient group therapy program designed to meet the unique needs of individuals typically 65 and older experiencing depression and/or anxiety related to life changes that are often associated with aging. Individuals may benefit from the Senior Life Solutions program if they are experiencing any of the following common indicators or triggers of

depression and anxiety:



- Changes in appetite
- Depression
- Difficulty sleeping
- Feelings of sadness or grief lasting more than two weeks
- Feelings of worthlessness or hopelessness
- family member
- Loss of energy
- Loss of interest in previously enjoyed activities
- Lost a spouse or close
 Recently experienced a traumatic event

Following an individual assessment, participants meet up to three times per week in a supportive, encouraging group setting. The program is also offering emotional support to patients from the comfort of their homes. Teletherapy services are offered via telephone or computer, without the need to meet in person.

The program staff includes a board-certified psychiatrist, licensed therapists, a registered nurse, and other professionals dedicated to the emotional well-being of the seniors in our community.

Anyone can refer a patient to the program, including a physician, family member, the patient, or another healthcare professional.

Laboratory

A second lab draw room was added to accommodate two patients at one time. The designated space decreases interruptions in workflow, which decreases patient wait times and increases patient satisfaction.



Med-Surg Nursing Station

The nurse's desk in the inpatient area was redesigned to allow team members to see the emergency department entrance and allow visitors and patients in. The walkways through to the nurse's station were closed to maintain privacy.



Cardiopulmonary Rehab

Cardiopulmonary rehab and respiratory therapy have a new location. They've been moved to the front of the building with their own entrance. The entrance reduces the wait time for patients in the program, and the extra room makes it easier for people to move freely.

Physical Therapy and Specialty Clinic Registration

A new registration desk was added to allow physical therapy and outpatient specialty clinic patients to bypass the front registration desk. This reduces congestion at the main registration desk.



Emergency Department

To better secure the Emergency Department nurses station, a new door and ballistic glass have been installed to enhance the safety of staff.
